Housing

The Liberal Democrats have consistently fought threats of housing sprawl to the north of Chelmsford/Broomfield. Liberal Democrats say that any Labour Government imposed housing should be in a separate settlement north of Boreham (the other side of the A12 from Boreham village. Do you agree?



Yes 256 or 65% No 41 or 10%

Transport

The Lib Dems have a vision to reduce congestion and pollution in Chelmsford. The plan is for a circular bus service linking main shopping centres to rail/bus interchange and university and main car parks. Do you support such a scheme?



Yes 303 or 77%

No 29 or 7%

Recycling

After a long delay, the Conservatives introduced kerbside collection of plastic bottles in January 2006 and cardboard in January 2007. Do you support Liberal Democrat campaigning for collection of other plastics & kitchen waste (separately from garden waste)?

Environment

Companies have submitted proposals for massive Mechanical Biological Treatment Plants at Rivenhall and Basildon (hopefully not Sandon). These plants take domestic and industrial waste and produce biogas; refuse derived fuel; and residual waste for landfill. The plants are very expensive and therefore the companies require 25 year contracts that guarantee substantial waste supply (at the expense of recycling). Liberal Democrats believe Essex County should encourage more recycling to avoid the need for such plants that are very large buildings and produce fuel for



incinerators. Do you agree?

Pavements

Tory County councillors turned down Liberal Democrat Budget amendments for money to be spent on crumbling pavements. Lib Dems believe that uneven pavements should be a priority as they are real problem for elderly people. Do you agree?

Council Tax

Council Tax has doubled over the last nine years. It hurts those on low incomes the most. Labour and Tories back it; The Lib Dems would abolish it. Would you:
